



RED WINES

2017 Cabernet Franc

Our 2017 Cab Franc is a very robust wine, with more flavor and color than is typical for this varietal. It was aged in a combination of new and three year old American Oak barrels.

2015 Petit Verdot

Petit Verdot, a full-bodied red wine that originates in southwestern France (in Bordeaux), has acclimated beautifully to Virginia. Our Double Gold Medal vintage offers aromas of mostly black fruit flavors ranging from plum, blackberry and blueberry to slightly lighter black cherry. Our late-harvest PV was aged in 100% new oak barrels and was awarded 2017 VA State Fair and 2018 Virginia Governor's Cup Gold Medals.

2017 Meritage

Meritage (a portmanteau of *merit* and *heritage*) is a blend of two or more of the red "noble" Bordeaux varieties. Our label is registered with the California-based Meritage Alliance. It is a blend of Cabernet Franc (40%), Petit Verdot (35%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (25%). In the glass a lovely blackberry nose with hints of plum. The palate offers a gently textured wine covering the ripe tannin that persist to the end with a depth and richness.

2015 Merlot

Our 2015 Merlot, made in the traditional "Bordeaux style," was aged in 100% new oak barrels. This is a full body wine with light, velvety tannins and notes of plum and blackberry fruit. Recent research shows that Merlot is an offspring of Cab Franc, which is notable in this particular wine. 2017 Silver medal winner – Virginia Governor's Cup.

2015 Thistle Red

A 50/50 blend of Petit Verdot and Merlot. Moderate tannins. 2016 Silver medal winner – Wines of the South.

2017 St. George Red Reserve

Estate grown, late harvest Chambourcin grapes. Chambourcin is a vigorous, French-American hybrid developed in the Loire Valley of France and has become a Virginia favorite and our signature red wine. 2017 St. George Reserve is aged in 2nd year oak barrels. Cherry flavors and heavy legs abound.

2016 Batteau Red

Our very popular Batteau Red is an estate grown Chambourcin wine containing 25% Highland Red port wine (2014). The Highland is an Amarone style wine where the grapes are dried before pressing to concentrate the natural sugars and flavors of the fruit. Batteau Red's sweetness and higher alcohol content are a result of the port wine addition. Very full bodied. Great as either an aperitif or after dinner wine.

Psalterium Red 2018

Estate grown Chambourcin grapes with 30% 2013 Tartan Red Port wine (aged in whiskey barrels). Drier than our Batteau Red, this wine was aged in 2nd year American Oak barrels.



WHITE AND BLUSH WINES

2019 Sparkling Vidal Blanc

Our first ever sparkling wine. Made from estate grown Vidal Blanc, it was aged in stainless steel and finished brute style (very dry). Our 2019 vintage was harvested at peak acidity and gently pressed making it a good candidate for Champagne-styled sparkling wine.

2019 Chardonnay

A dry, crisp and fruity Chardonnay that was aged in new American Oak barrels. 1980s California style, with subtle buttery notes. Our best Chardonnay in ten years.

2017 Seyval Blanc

Our Seyval Blanc is 100% estate grown and was harvested in mid-August with high acidity and young, ripe flavors. Aged in stainless steel for 13 months, this Governor's Cup award winning wine has characteristic citrus elements in the aroma and taste.

2017 Scott's Landing White

A mostly dry blend of Seyval Blanc (80%) and Chardonnay (20%), Scott's Landing White is lightly oaked with <1% residual sugar. This wine embodies a wonderful hint of grapefruit.

2017 Thistle White

Thistle White is 100% estate grown Vidal Blanc. This is an off dry wine that is aged in stainless steel tanks. It is fruity with notes of grapefruit, melon and pineapple. Contains 2.5 percent residual sugar.

2017 Thistle Blush

Blush wines (also called rosé wines) are made from various red wine grapes. During production, the juice and grape skins have limited contact (about four hours of maceration), which restricts the formation of deep red colors. Our 2017 Thistle Blush, with less than 1% residual sugar, is made from an early harvest of our estate grown Chambourcin grapes. It has a great balance of sugar and acid. It was aged in stainless steel for 12 months.



SPECIALTY WINES & SANGRIA

2015 Tartan Red

This Port-style wine is made from late harvest Chambourcin grapes and fortified with brandy that was distilled from estate grown Chambourcin wine. Tartan embodies cherry flavors, smoky essence and subtle vanilla notes. Tartan is aged in whiskey barrels for 3 years. 18% alcohol.

2013 Highland Red

Our exceptional dark Port-style Highland Red is made from nearly double the amount of late harvest, estate grown Chambourcin grapes that have been dried to concentrate the natural sugars and flavors of the fruit (termed Amarone style in Italy). Highland Red is fortified with VA distilled brandy that is made from our Chambourcin grapes and then aged for two plus years in whisky barrels. 18% alcohol. Savor as an after dinner treat or on its own.

Sangria

Our famous Sangria is made fresh daily using St. George Red Chambourcin wine and fruit juices. It is served by the 1.5 L bottle, growler (off-site only) or with ice in a 16 oz. cup.

Pricing notes:

Glass not included in tasting, but can be purchased for \$2.00.
